Research Committee: Accomplishments Last 12 Months

- **Refocused monthly workshop (formerly “webinar”) content to include workshops for Chairs.**
 - Goal: to launch a series of webinars focused on research-related topics that would be relevant to our membership.
 - Survey distributed to solicit input about topics of interest and results were reviewed by the Research Committee.
 - Plan moving forward:
 - schedule these webinars 3x/yr: May, September and January
 - organize these workshops as panel discussions
 - inaugural session to focus on supporting career development of junior faculty P-S (e.g., financial support, mentoring)
- **Continued the Visiting Research Professor Program.**
 - RFA distributed last fall with a new online application for the 2022-23 application cycle.
 - Dr. Yatin Vyas appointed leader of this initiative.
- **Continued the AMSPDC *Journal of Pediatrics* Page.**
 - Dr. David Gozal 's manuscript entitled “*A Pediatric Telemedicine Research Agenda: Another Important Task for Pediatric Chairs*”, was published in December 2022 (DOI: [10.1016/j.jpeds.2022.07.0480](https://doi.org/10.1016/j.jpeds.2022.07.0480)).
 - The manuscript had been reviewed by the Research Committee.
- **Provided the AMSPDC Planning Committee with recommendations for scientific content for this 2023 Annual Meeting.**
- **Supported pipeline development.**
 - A proposal for expanded eligibility criteria for the Integrated Research Pathway developed in the fall of 2021 by Drs. Sallie Permar and Rasheed Gbadegesin (Associate Dean for Physician Scientist Development and Co-Director of Duke CTSA-KL2 Program), along with Drs. Wade Clapp and Stephanie Davis, was reviewed by the Research Committee.
 - The proposal was presented to the ABP in early 2022.
 - Dr. Suzanne K. Woods, Executive Vice President of the ABP, joined the Research Committee Meeting in 11/22 to present an overview of “*Residency Training and Research Pathways*”.
 - ABP is committed to providing flexibility for residents who wish to pursue research during training.

Goals for the next 12 months

- **Update and expand the “new” AMSPDC website.**
 - Focus on research resources for chairs (i.e., the Research Toolbox), specifically addressing DEI.
- **Launch the new Workshop for Chairs.**
 - Chairs will be encouraged to invite research-focused departmental leadership to the workshops (e.g., Vice Chairs of Research).
- **Promote the Visiting Research Professor Program.**
 - Broadcast an RFA with link to the online application for the 2023-24 application cycle.
 - Solicit from 2022 hosting Chairs an update on progress in addressing metrics identified in their applications.
- **Participate in the AMSPDC Member Support System and Consultation Program.**
- **Continue to contribute to the AMSPDC *Journal of Pediatrics* Pages.**
 - Dr. Stephanie Davis, with the help of Drs. David Gozal, Raphael Hirsch, and Gary Silverman, led an initiative in 2021 to survey Chairs about expectations for senior scientists.
 - Survey results were presented to the Research Committee.
 - Dr. Davis and her team have generated a manuscript entitled “*Supporting Career Transitions of Senior Faculty: Perspectives of Chairs and Full Professors*”, in collaboration with leaders for faculty development at UNC and Columbia, who had also conducted surveys of their full professors.
 - The manuscript, in preparation, will be submitted to the AMSPDC Pages in the *Journal of Pediatrics* this year.
- **Support pipeline development.**
 - Continue close engagement with the PSDP, led by Dr. Sallie Permar, and FIS, led by Dr. Wade Clapp to continue to provide suggestions and support to enhance these programs.
 - Collaborate with other groups as appropriate (e.g., National Physician Scientist Collaborative Workgroup – NPSCW, PAS).
- **Provide the AMSPDC Planning Committee recommendations for scientific content for the 2024 Annual Meeting.**
